## **Agape/Outreach Ministry**

Greetings First Christian Friends and Family,

This is Deacon Joseph Vanpool with just a few notes about the Agapé and Outreach programs. The Agapé program is run by several teams of wonderful, dedicated people. The folks that we feed and clothe rely on us and have become like family. This program has been operating for several years and has been successful as part of our endeavor to serve our neighbors and our community in the spirit of the love of Jesus.

Sadly, our funding is running low. The grant that has been financing the program is nearly depleted. There are grant applications and fundraising events being planned soon.

Our kitchen pantry used for the Agape meal and our little pantry out front are both in need of your generous help and donations. I'm asking everybody to help us out with donations of canned and nonperishable food items. Dig out your cupboards, clean out your pantry, and donate what you can (please check the expiration dates). When you go grocery shopping for your own pantries maybe pick up just a few extra cans at the same time. It will all be used and appreciated. There is a cart set up in the front of the sanctuary and a collection box in the fellowship hall next to the kitchen. Please donate generously as you're able.

Also, as I will be leaving to begin a new life in Oregon in the beginning of July, so we will also need just a few more volunteers for a few hours a month to cook and serve on the third Wednesday of the month. If you are interested and can commit, please see Konrad or Joseph and we'll see what we can do to get you going.

#### Monetary Donations Are Also Needed for Agape Meal Program

On average we have about 60 folks at the Wednesday night Agape Meal. As examples of costs of single meals, we can serve a hot dog meal for about \$2.20 a person and spaghetti for around \$2.43 a person. Therefore, going with the higher meal cost it would about \$145.80 total for one night. As you all may know we have been operating off donations that were directly given to support the feeding ministry. However, as with all budget issues, we are getting very low on funds to support this program. Any help would be greatly appreciated.
