

Kathy's White Chicken Chili Recipe

Kathy Cooper kindly shares her delicious recipe for the chili that so many of you enjoyed at the recent FCC Potluck Dinner:

1 medium onion finely chopped and sautéed in olive oil (1 TBS)

add: 1 clove garlic finely diced and cook 1 minute

Then add: 1 tsp oregano, ground cumin, salt, black pepper and stir to make a paste (add more oil if needed). Add 32 oz. chicken broth, 1/4 tsp cayenne pepper and stir

1 4 oz. can green chilies (or roast your own and dice)

1 can cream of chicken soup

1 can white beans (your choice) drained and rinsed

2 cups corn

4 oz. cream cheese and 1/2 to 3/4 c half and half

Add cooked chicken as much as you like

Heat in a pan or put in your slow cooker


